

**ERSAMUS + project "Poster Art", first meeting in Gijón, Spain  
9-13 May 2016.**

From 9 to 13 May 2016, a group of five students of the audiovisual sector and two teachers from our school IISS "Majorana"-Bari, together with teachers and students from Spain, Austria, Macedonia, Poland, Portugal, and Romania have been hosted by "Colegio Santo Angel de la Guarda" in the Asturia region.

We were warmly welcomed with posters and introduced each other in the school theatre.

We spent five, intense days during which we were involved in lots of activities organized by the hosting school. To break the ice, students, divided into groups, took part in socializing games in the open air. Spanish students were also perfect guides and showed us the school and the museum Casa Natal de Jovellanos where they presented "El Retablo del Mar", the stunning wooden sculpture made by the Asturian artist Sebastián Miranda in 1971. "El Retablo del Mar" is also the Spanish theme of our project.

Among the other activities: group works on the collage techniques, the treasure hunt in the city centre of Salas, a guided tour of the Cathedral of San Salvador and of the two pre-Romanesque monuments of San Miguel de Lillo and Santa Maria del Naranco in Oviedo.

It has been a wonderful experience for our students who have had the possibility to practice the English language, to socialize with other European students and at the same time they have enriched their cultural background by getting in touch with uses, habits, dishes of different countries.

Italy is the next hosting country and we are looking forward to welcoming our partners in our school in October.
